

Oxford Metrica & Ernst & Young Study

- Clear, empirical connection between risk quality and shareholder value performance
- High quality risk management is strongly correlated with low cash flow volatility
- Risk quality is a strategic issue and an essential aspect of corporate governance procedures
- When asset protection fails, the value impact can be significant and is typically destiny determining



